

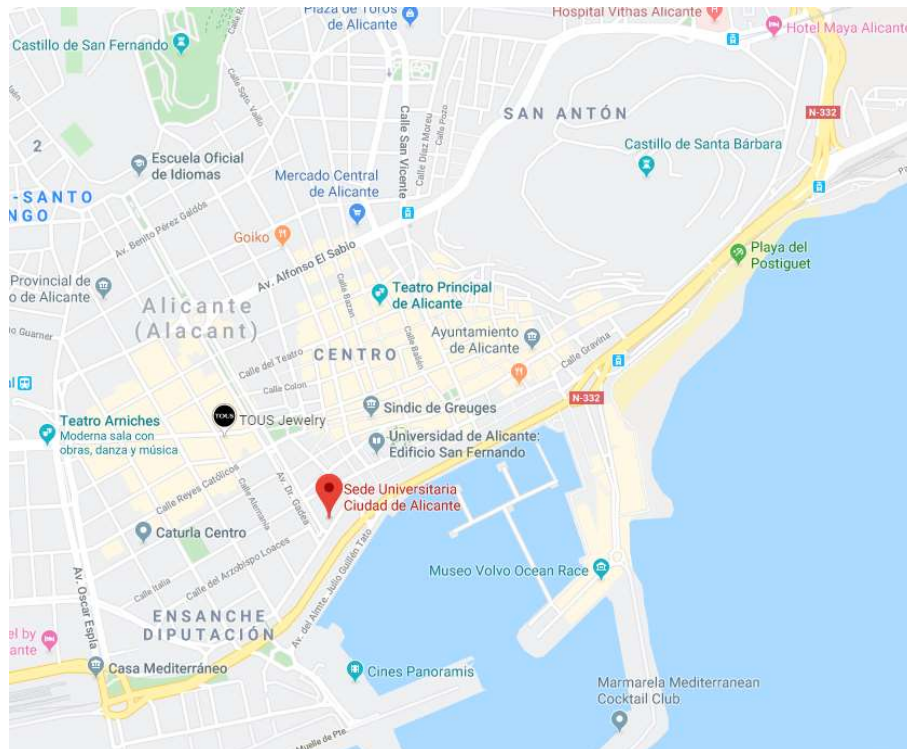

Indications for Poster presentation & Doctoral Colloquium

Poster presentation: maximum dimensions of printed posters: DIN-A0 (84'1cm x 118'9 / 33,1 x 46,8 inches). Presenters must ensure an adequate resolution of figures and text. All presenters will bring the printed final version of their poster to the venue.

Doctoral Colloquium: each participant will prepare a 10 minute presentation and participate in a subsequent discussion with other presenters.
